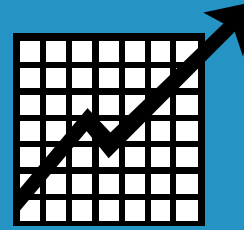

Underage Drinking Laws and Legal Consequences

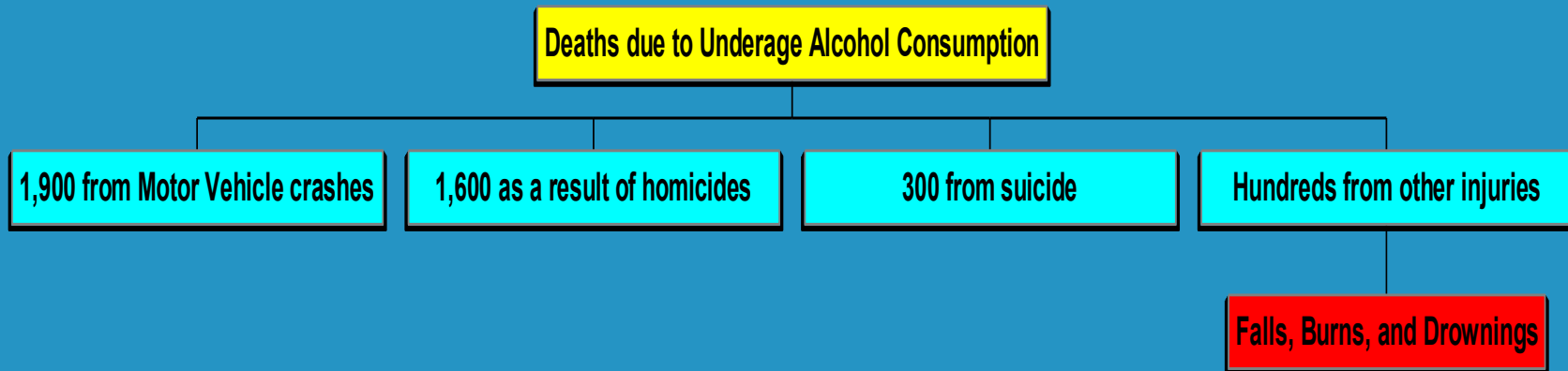
Legal Consequences For Minors

- **Fines**
- **Suspension of driver's license**
- **Community Service**
- **Mandatory alcohol awareness courses**
- **Possible jail time**

Laws For Minors Illegal to:

- **Possess Alcohol**
- **Consume Alcohol**
- **Purchase Alcohol**
- **Attempt to Purchase Alcohol**
- **Misrepresent Age**
- **Drive with a negligible Blood Alcohol Content (varies in some states)**

Underage Drinking Laws Affect Adults

Illegal for Adults to:

- Buy or give alcohol to minor
- Allow minor to consume alcohol on persons property
- Allow minor to use the adult's ID
- Sell alcohol to anyone under 21 (even if they misrepresent their age)

Consequences:

- Jail Time
- Fines
