Distracted Driving

In 2011, 3,331 people were killed in crashes involving a distracted driver, and 387,000 people were injured in similar accidents.

11% of distracted people were under the age of 20

40 % of teens say they have been in a car with a driver that was using their cell phone in a way that put others in danger

Sending or receiving a text takes your eyes off the road for 4.6 seconds and at 55 mph you can drive the length of an entire football field and you have no idea what you have done

Drunk Driving

Drunk driving causes 1/3 of traffic fatalities

In 2006, 40% of drunk drivers were speeding

In 2007, 13,000 Americans were involved with alcohol impairment

In 2010, 211 children were killed while with a drunk driver

In 2011, 9,878 people were killed due to drunk drivers

3 out of 10 Americans will be involved in alcohol related accidents at some point in their life

Every 90 seconds someone is injured due to drunk driving

Every 40 minutes someone will be killed by a drunk driver
