No, go to page 2



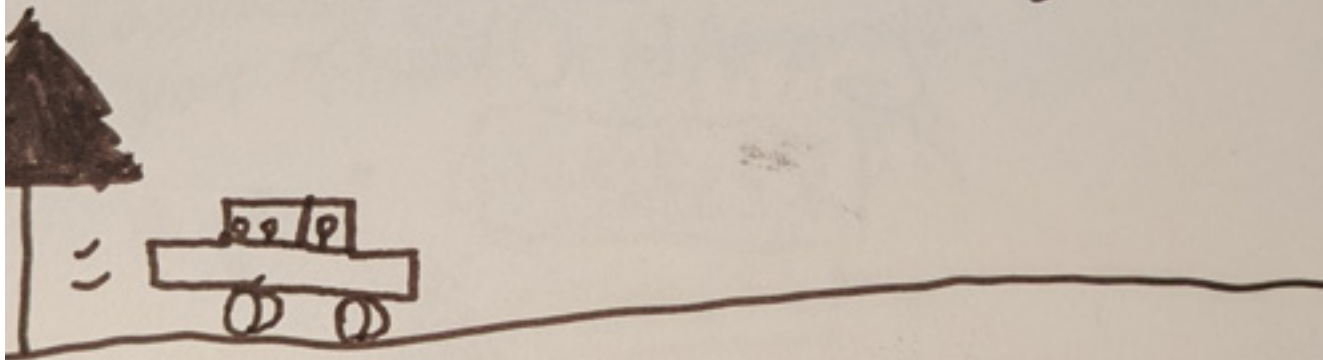

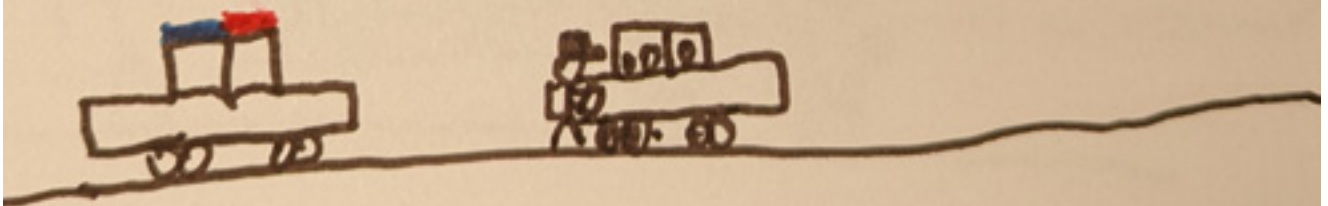

Yes, go to page 6

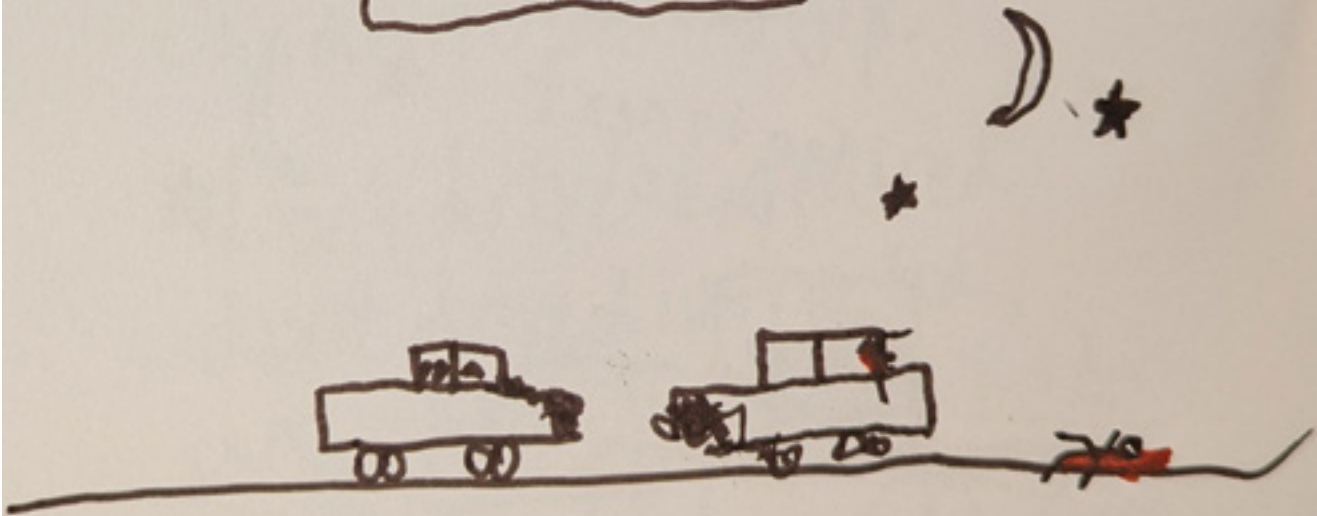
No, go to page 7

Restart?

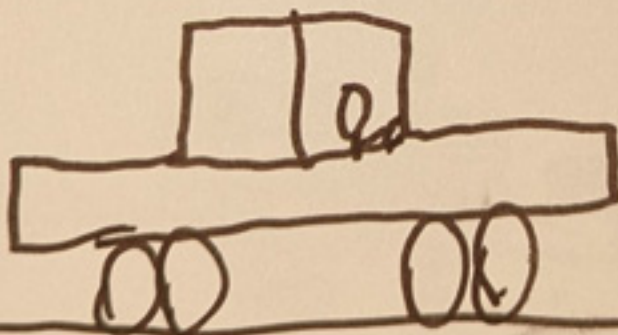
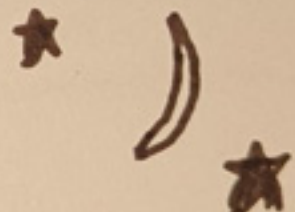


You decide to stay sober. You are able to drive yourself and your friends home safely from the party. Your smart decisions saved lives.
